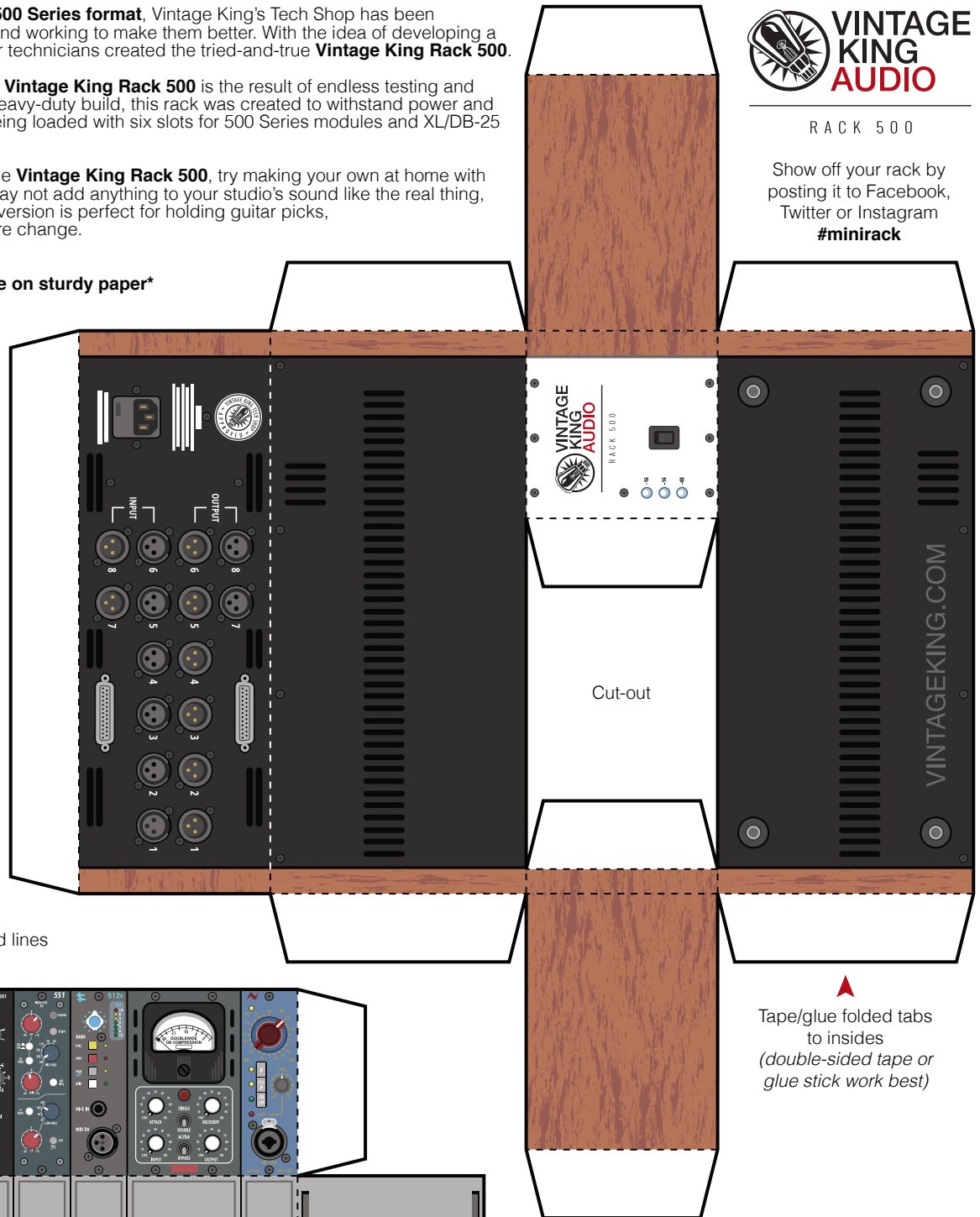

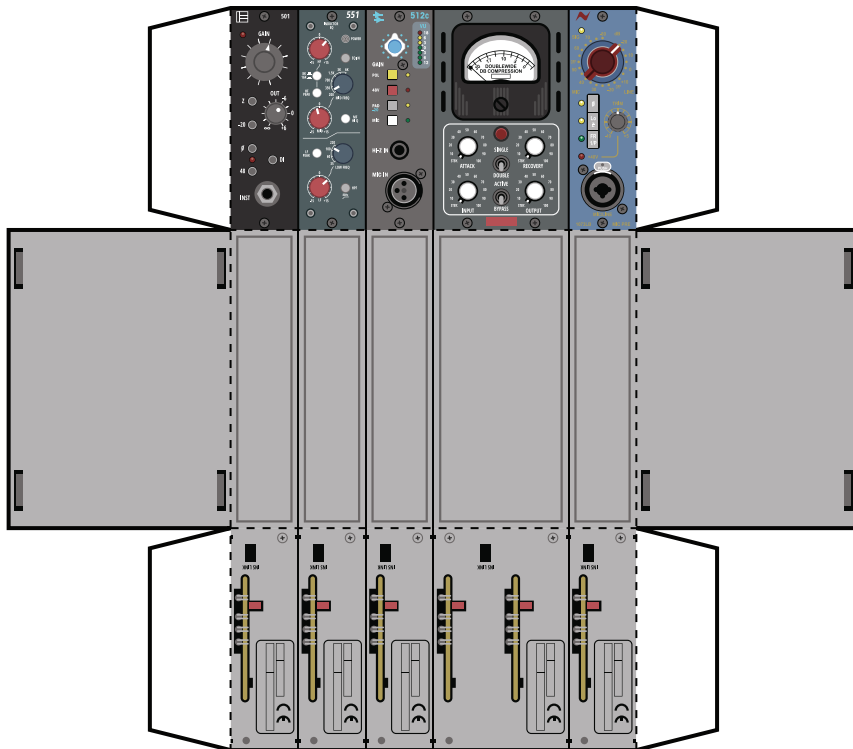
Print template on sturdy paper
